

**Knox County Student Enrollment Regulations**  
**K-12 Students Residing in the Knox County School District**  
**and**  
**Requesting to Attend a School in the**  
**Corbin Independent School District**  
**Effective May 6, 2014**

The Knox County Board of Education and the Corbin Independent Board of Education have approved a **Nonresident Student Agreement** for the **2015-2016** school year allowing 405 nonresident K-12 students from the Knox County School District to attend schools in the Corbin Independent School District. The agreement allows any and all Corbin resident students to attend schools in the Knox County School District for the 2015-2016 school year.

**Knox Student Enrollment Regulations**

These regulations contain the requirements for nonresident Knox County School District students to be eligible to enroll in the Corbin Independent School District. Central Office administrators at 108 Roy Kidd Avenue, Corbin will make all decisions as to the enrollment of all students.

The following enrollment regulations provide the conditions to be followed in the implementation of the **2015-2016 Nonresident Student Agreement** with the Knox County Board of Education, allowing 405 Knox County nonresident students to attend Corbin Independent schools:

1. The **Knox County Student Enrollment Regulations** only apply to nonresident students from the Knox County School District for the 2015-2016 school year.
2. Completion and submittal of the form, ***“Knox Student Enrollment Application,”*** is required to be considered for enrollment as a student from the Knox County School District.
3. The ***“Knox Student Enrollment Application”*** will be accepted in the office of the Corbin Board of Education at 108 Roy Kidd Avenue, Corbin, Kentucky 40701 at the designated times. Office hours are 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
4. Corbin school staff shall refer all Knox County School District resident inquiries related to enrolling in the Corbin Independent School District to central office staff, with central office administrators making all final decisions as to the enrollment of students.
5. The Corbin Independent School District reserves the administrative authority to close the student enrollment for a specific grade[s] from out-of-district students when the enrollment at that grade meets or exceeds current cap size levels.
6. Corbin school employees who reside in the Knox County School District will follow the regulations set forth in KRS 157.350 [4] and the regulations of the Kentucky Department of Education for their children to attend the Corbin Independent School District.
7. The Corbin Independent School District will accept 405 nonresident Knox County School District students per the ***Nonresident Student Agreement*** for the 2015-2016 school year.

8. Nonresident Knox students in excess of the allowed 405 nonresident Knox County School District may enroll in the Corbin School District with the Knox resident paying the yearly tuition of \$3,000 for the 2015-2016 school year, provided the enrollment at the grade[s] does not meet or exceed cap size.
9. **PRIORITY OF SELECTION - In 2015-2016**, there are four [4] **Priority Levels** that will be followed in the eligibility for selection of the **405 nonresident students** from the Knox County School District attending the Corbin Independent School District. The **Priority Levels** for the eligibility to enroll in Corbin schools will follow the following priority order:

- A. {Priority A} – Current 2014-2015 Knox County Students** - As of Friday, May 22, 2015, any nonresident students from the Knox County School District enrolled in the Corbin Independent School District who will be a K-12 student in 2015-2016 will be enrolled and counted in the 405 number for 2015-2016 and shall not pay tuition. **Priority A** students include the Knox County School District students currently paying tuition to attend a Corbin school. **No application or action is required** by the parents of students identified in **Priority A** to continue enrollment in the Corbin School District for the 2015-2016 school year.
- B. {Priority B} - Siblings of Current 2014-2015 Knox County Students** – Starting Monday, May 11, 2015 at noon and ending at noon on Wednesday, May 13, 2015, residents of the Knox County School District with siblings under **Priority A** may submit to the Corbin Board Office the **“Knox County Student Enrollment Application”** to apply for enrollment of the sibling in the Corbin School District.
- Applications for siblings submitted after Wednesday, May 13, 2015 (noon) will be considered with the **Priority D - Open Enrollment** and selected on a first-come, first-served basis, determined by the date and time the application is received in the Central Office of the Corbin Board of Education and availability of openings per the 405 nonresident student agreement.
- C. {Priority C} – Grades K-3 Students** – Beginning Wednesday, May 13, 2015 at noon, and ending on Friday, May 15, 2015 at noon, residents of the Knox County School District with a child in grades K-3 desiring to attend a Corbin school may submit the form, **“Knox County Student Enrollment Application,”** to the Central Office of the Corbin Board of Education. Any siblings of the K-3 applicant are included as a **Priority C** applicant. Selection of **Priority C** applicants will be on a first-come, first-served basis, determined by the date and time the application is received in the Central Office of the Corbin Board of Education and availability of openings per the 405 nonresident student agreement.
- D. {Priority D} – Grades K-12 Open Enrollment** - The open enrollment for any nonresident Knox County School District student in grades K-12 not covered under **Priorities A, B, and C**, will begin on Monday, May 18, 2015 at noon and continue throughout the 2015-2016 school year. The selection will be on a first-come, first-served basis, determined by the date and time the application is received in the Central Office of the Corbin Board of Education and availability of openings per the 405 nonresident student agreement.
